## Kitchen and Lounge

Guests are welcome to use the refrigerator and microwave in the kitchen located off the main hallway. Ice (freezer) and ice buckets are also available. The lounge area, next to the kitchen, is a relaxing space for guests to enjoy. Please be respectful of other guests while using these spaces and keep the noise level low whenever possible.

## Drinking Water

Filtered drinking water is available in water coolers located in the main hall and in the Lounge area. Pitchers and extra glasses are also available in the Lounge.

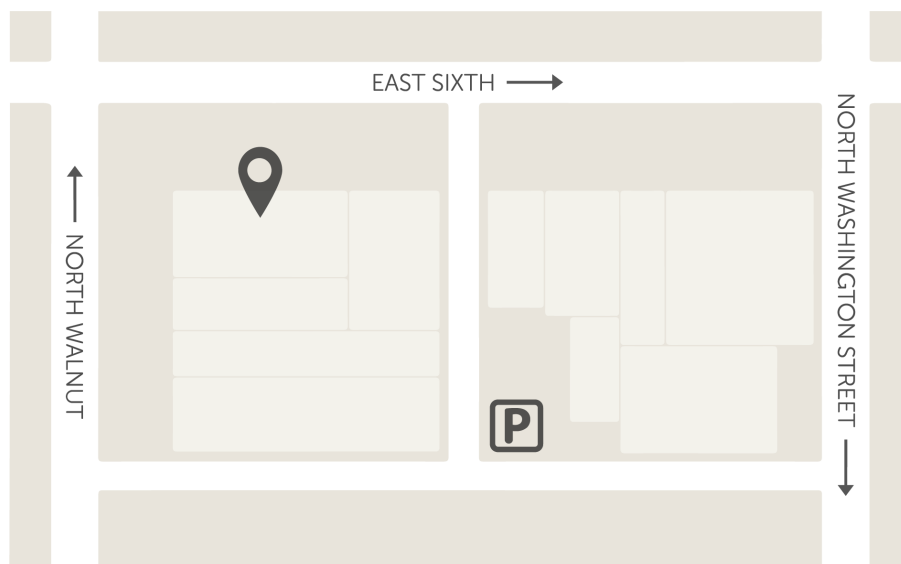

## Guest Parking

Parking spots are located in the alley behind our building. The best way to access the parking area is off Walnut Street between Kirkwood Ave and 6th Street (directly across from the Courthouse building on the Square). Our six spaces are marked with WALNUT STREET INN. Walnut Street Inn parking spaces equip standard size vehicles only: extended lengths and extra wide vehicles will not fit. To enter the Inn, walk through the alley to Walnut Street, turn right and our front door is near 6th Street.



## Downtown Parking

If you are unable to find a space in our parking lot, the following options are available:

\*Metered Street Parking: Monday through Saturday - 9am to 9pm, Free on Sundays and City Holidays and from 9pm to 9am

\*Lot 5 – Located on E 6<sup>th</sup> Street, (less than 2 blocks from the Inn): First 3 hours are Free, Metered Monday through Friday - 8am to 5pm, Free after 5pm daily and Free on Weekends (Saturday & Sunday).

\*Downtown Parking Garages: Located at the following intersections (for more information regarding locations and pricing visit - [bloomington.in.gov/parksmart](http://bloomington.in.gov/parksmart)): 4<sup>th</sup> & Walnut Street, 7<sup>th</sup> & Walnut Street and 6<sup>th</sup> & Morton Street

## In-Room Amenities

All guest rooms include a coffee/tea brewer, iron and ironing board, hair dryer, alarm clock/radio and a flat screen TV. In addition to these amenities, a few of our rooms also have kitchenettes with a mini-fridge and microwave. Please feel free to contact us if you have any questions regarding these items.

## Television

Each room is equipped with DIRECTV which allows you to view local and national channels as well as listen to satellite radio stations. A channel guide is located near the TV for your convenience (we do not offer pay-per-view at this time). The DIRECTV remote is programmed to control the TV power and volume in addition to the satellite channel selection. Please note that during a heavy wind or rain storm a 'loss of signal' may occur and we will try our best to remedy this situation in a timely manner whenever possible.

## Heating and Cooling

Each room is equipped with a wall mount unit (with the exception of the Maple Room) which is controlled by the white "Klimaire" remote. The orange button in the middle of the remote turns the unit on and off. Use the 'Mode' button to choose from Cool or Heat (**Please keep the unit in 'Cool' mode during the spring and summer months**). The 'Fan Speed' button will adjust the air flow from the unit and the arrow 'Temp' buttons allow you to adjust to the desired temperature.

Space heaters are available to provide heat if needed during the spring and summer months while the wall mount units are in 'Cool' mode. They can also be used for secondary heat during the cooler months. Please use the following precautions when using these units:

- \*Do not cover and keep **3** feet of empty space around unit when in use.
- \*Plug unit directly into wall outlet, no extension cords please.
- \*When in use, unit is warm/hot to the touch, use the handle only to move unit if needed and use caution when adjusting the temperature.
- \*Please unplug unit when not in use.

The Maple Room is equipped with a thermostat located on the wall just inside the door. Set the system switch to 'Cool', 'Heat' or 'Off' then adjust to the desired temperature with the gray arrow buttons.

## Door Codes & Key Cards

Entrance to the Inn and guest rooms require separate 4-digit codes which are changed after every guest check-out.

## Guest Room locks

All guest rooms are equipped with a key pad lock as well as a secondary lock. The key pads automatically lock when you close the door (as long as the switch located on the inside of the handle is in a horizontal position).

## Inn Exits

There are two exits located at the Inn, one at each end of the main hallway. Both are highlighted by exit signs should there be a loss of power. Each guest rooms is equipped with a nightlight/flashlight if needed.
